This may be the result of divorce, abandonment, abuse, incarceration, addictions, premature death, or a physically present but emotionally absent father. If a woman is unable to heal from these wounds, she may be impacted by them for her entire life. In Kia's talk, she helps women see that overcoming the pain of father wounds is possible when we exchange our pain for God's perfect love.
